



FIH Masters Panel Terms of Reference

1. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- 1.1** To co-ordinate and guide the development of International Masters Hockey for men and women world-wide.
- 1.2** To encourage the development of Masters Hockey through the Continental Federations and all FIH member nations.

2. AUTHORITY, STRUCTURE AND MEMBERSHIP

- 2.1** The Panel/Committee derives its authority from the FIH Executive Board and adheres to the Committee and Advisory Panel protocols established by the Executive Board.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES

- 3.1** To encourage and support FIH member nations and Continental Federations to develop Masters Hockey programmes, structures and events.
- 3.2** To advise on the branding and promotion of Masters Hockey to increase the number of players continuing to play hockey.
- 3.3** To provide Masters Hockey with access to professional advice on all aspects of international tournament management
- 3.3** To support the organisation and management of Masters Hockey tournaments
- 3.5** To encourage FIH member nations to enter teams in international Masters Hockey tournaments.
- 3.4** To support and facilitate the staging of Masters international tournaments alongside the Olympic Games, World Cup, World League, Champions Events and Continental Federation Cup tournaments.
- 3.7** To explore potential sponsors for Masters Hockey
- 3.5** To seek the support from Masters Hockey for the Foundation Trust activities of FIH
- 3.9** To network with sport or other institutions which have successful Masters' programmes or events to enable sharing of information and good practice.
- 3.10** To report on Masters Hockey to the FIH Executive Board.
