



Notification of Voting Member and Observer at an IMHA Congress

Each Member Nation is entitled to appoint a Delegate to attend the Congress Meeting and is also permitted to have an observer accompany their Delegate at the meeting.

Observers may, with the permission of the President or Chairperson, speak at the meetings but are not entitled to vote.

The Hon. Secretary must be notified of the name and contact details of the Voting Delegate and Observer who will be attending the meeting. Failure to notify details of the Voting Delegate and Observer may result in them being ineligible to vote.
